Step 1

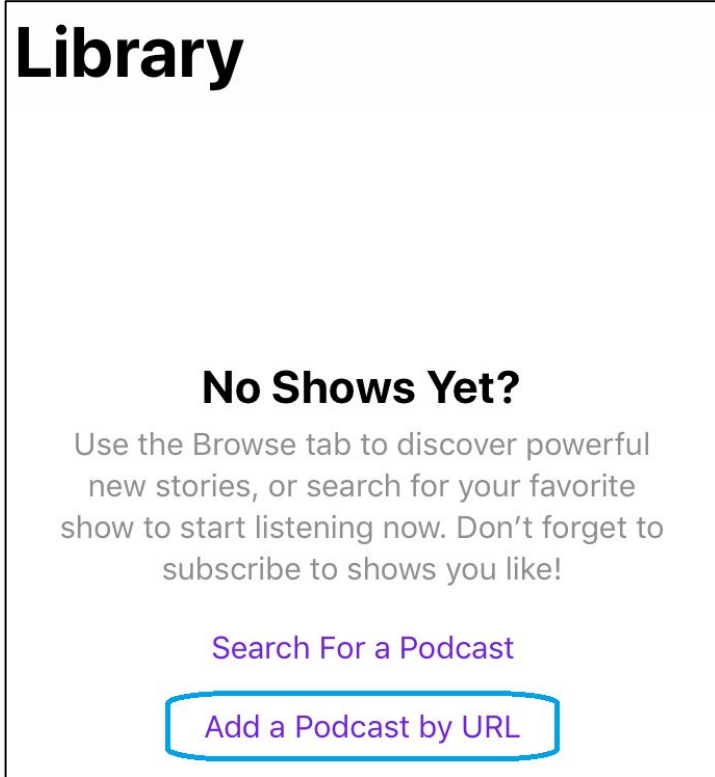
Open the **Apple Podcasts** app.

Click the **Library** icon at the bottom of the screen as shown below.



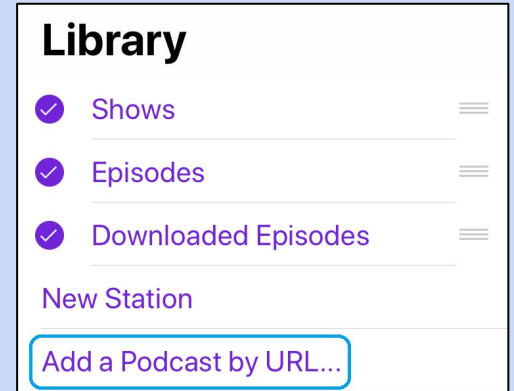
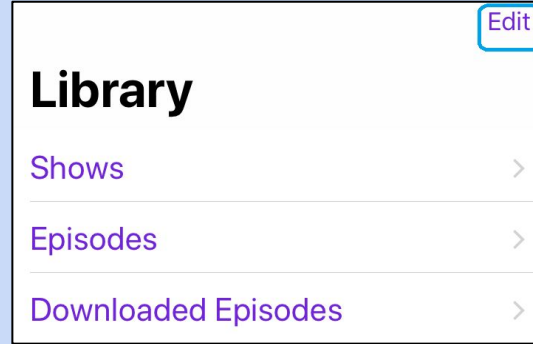
Step 2

If you have no existing podcasts, you will see the option **"Add a Podcast by URL"** towards the middle of the screen (see below)



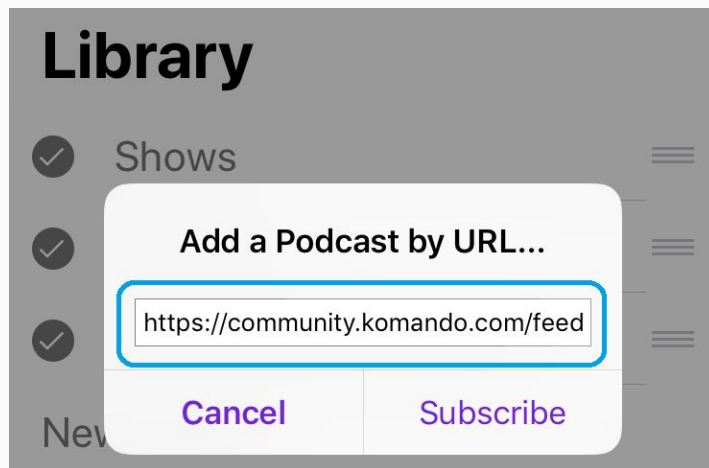
However...

If you already have podcasts in your Library, you will need to hit **"Edit"** in the top-right corner and then **"Add a Podcast by URL"**



Step 3

Enter the podcast's RSS feed: <https://community.komando.com/feed/tkks/>



Click **Subscribe**.

Enter your Komando Community **username** (your account email works too) and **password** when prompted.
